As a member of the MSC Music Ensemble Program your child commits to:

- Committing to an ensemble as our program overlaps terms and semesters and changes to the team can be disruptive to the group dynamic.
- Attend all rehearsals. Should your child be unable to make a rehearsal for any reason the ensemble <u>director must be contacted directly by the parent / guardian</u> via SEQTA.
- If your child has forgotten their instrument, they are **still expected to attend rehearsal.**
- Attend all performances for the ensemble/s. In extreme cases where this is not possible please notify your ensemble director, in writing, no less than two weeks prior to the concert date.
- **Be ready to play at the designated rehearsal time**. Late attendance is disrespectful to your peers and staff who have made the effort to be there for you. Students should arrive early to set up their instruments, the rehearsal room and tune for the rehearsal to start on time.
- **Keep all music in good condition**, marking parts only in pencil and not creasing paper. Music Folders can be available upon request.
- **Practise regularly** to ensure smooth rehearsals for everyone.

Performance Uniform

When participating in a concert or competition students are required to wear the following:

- Music polo shirt,
- Formal uniform trousers, grey for boys and navy for girls
- Black or blue socks and clean black leather school shoes.
- Hair clean and brushed away from the face. Shoulder length hair must be tied back.
- Make up and jewellery is not permitted.

Ensemble Folders

If relevant, students will be loaned a music folder. This folder is the student's responsibility for the entirety of the year that they are with the ensemble. All care should be taken to avoid lost or damaged folders and to demonstrate appropriate respect for the copies.

Rehearsal Timetable Clashes

Rehearsal and Private Lessons should appear in SEQTA timetables. If it happens that there is a timetable clash between a music commitment and an academic, sporting or other commitment, the staff and parent/guardian will need to collaborate to organize share arrangements. It is important to look ahead and notice these within a respectful timeline. The onus is on the parent / guardian to alert the Tutors to a clash. Tutors do not currently have access to assessment and excursion dates and details. Should a clash occur, please message the tutor through SEQTA as soon as possible.

Auditions

Where there are limited places available on a particular instrument/voice within an ensemble, students may be required to audition for their place in the group. This will be organised as required. Students will be given adequate notice of the audition.
